


REDDING**INSTRUCTIONS****MODEL NO. 25 TURRET PRESS
WITH 6 STATION TURRET HEAD****ASSEMBLY AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Your New Redding Model No. 25 Turret Press comes to you with all major parts assembled.

Simply mount your Redding Model No. 25 Turret Press securely to a strong bench or other solid support by means of 5/16" mounting bolts.

The turret should rotate freely, but index positively at each station. The turret head handle should be threaded into the turret handle hole until snug. You will note that there are two

handle mounting holes and you may wish to move the handle to the other hole after you have mounted your dies and/or powder measure, or use two handles. An extra handle is an available option. This allows the most convenient handle position at the user's option.

The press handle can now be mounted in the press linkage handle hole, where it is held in position by means of the handle lock nut as shown in the illustration. Tighten lock nut securely.

The ram on the Model No. 25 Turret Press is designed to accept any "Standard" shell holder: The shell holders are retained in position by the Redding "Snap-In" feature. This "Snap-In" feature permits you to rotate the shell holder to the most convenient operating position depending on whether you prefer to work from the right or left. It also permits easy changing of shell holders.

The turret head is made to accept any quality 7/8" - 14 threaded dies with **no** bushings or adapters required. The dies and/or powder measure can now be mounted. The instructions for the use of reloading dies and other accessories come packed with these items. With a little experimentation, you will soon discover that many multiple combinations can be obtained in the mounting sequence of dies and powder measures, permitting two or more calibers to be set up at one time.

Be sure and apply a small amount of lubricant on the press ram from time to time and keep the rest of the press in a clean, dry condition.
